

Torrey Town Board

March 10, 2009

The regular monthly meeting of the town board held on March 10, 2009 at the town hall 56 Geneva St Dresden NY was called to order at 7:35pm by Supervisor Flynn.

Mr. Flynn led the pledge of allegiance.

Mr. Flynn introduced representatives of AES Greenidge who gave a well received 90 minute presentation on the Lockwood Ash Site “ Landfill” at Swarthout Road. Many questions by residents were answered. Site construction in phases was explained in detail, water collection and run off monitoring, materials in placed, sediment ponds, daily activity, DEC involvement in the operation. Tim Chambers requested if there are any problems regarding this site he would appreciate all phone call. He gave his contact numbers as cell # 315-719-8333 and at the plant 536-2359 ext. 3230

After a round of applause the Supervisor extended to Mr. Chambers an invitation to attend a future meeting to present updates on the plant itself.

Mr. Flynn presented the abstracts of vouchers for review.

Motion by Mrs. Francisco, 2nd Mr. Morris that the bills on the General A & B accounts in the amount of \$ 6202..01 be paid, carried by all.

Motion by Mr. Morris, 2nd Mrs. Francisco, that the bills on the highway DA & DB accounts in the amount of \$ 8991.41 to be paid, carried by all.

Motion by Mr. Martini, 2nd Mr. Morris, that the bills on the Watershed SD accounts in the amount of \$ 50.97 to be paid, carried by all.

Two sealed gravel bids were received and opened publicly.

3/09/09 Penn Yan Transport, Penn Yan, New York, bid of \$12.00/ton delivered

3/10/09 Timothy Hansen – Penn Yan, New York bid of \$2.25/ yd

Motion Mr Flynn, 2nd Mr. Morris, to accept Tim Hansen’s bid and award him the 2009 contract to supply the town with bank run gravel.

Mr. Flynn read a letter of resignation from Marjorie Scherer dated February 25, 2009.

Mr. Mashewske presented the highway report for month of February.

He reported that the Bomag roller shared with the Town of Milo has mechanical problems. A hydrolic pump cannot be replaced due to the age of the machine and unavailable parts.

He will check with another supplier and report next month.

Motion by Mr. Martini, 2nd Mrs. Francisco, that in the interest of safety of the Town starting in April – May 09 all highway employees with CDL (Commercial Drivers License) will be required to have a “DOT” physical every two years with a copy of Doctor’s certificate retained in their personnel file. The cost for these bi-yearly physicals will be at the Town expense. Carried by all.

The board received 3 applications for two newly created seats for the Planning board. These will be sent to the Planning board for review and recommendation.

The board received a application from Patrick Hoke interested in serving on the Zoning Board of Appeals. Motion by Mr. Flynn, 2nd Mr. Martini to appoint Patrick Hoke to fill the vacant seat for the unexpired term to 2013, carried by all.

Ron Kenville reported that he will be attending school for 4 days this month He had no watershed business for the month of February, and a few code inspections.

There being no further business before the board, Mr. Flynn made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Mr. Martini carried at 9:30 PM.
